

Using the System Software Update CD

TO UPDATE THE SYSTEM SOFTWARE



NOTE: Always keep the System Software Update CD with the associated system software CDs. Reinstall this update file and any other required update files whenever you reinstall system software. The system reboots automatically after you install an update file.

1. Find the DCCS50 IP address on a recent Configuration Report.

Look for a recent Configuration Report on or near the Document Centre ColorSeries 50 (DCCS50). If you do not find a recent Configuration Report, print one as follows:

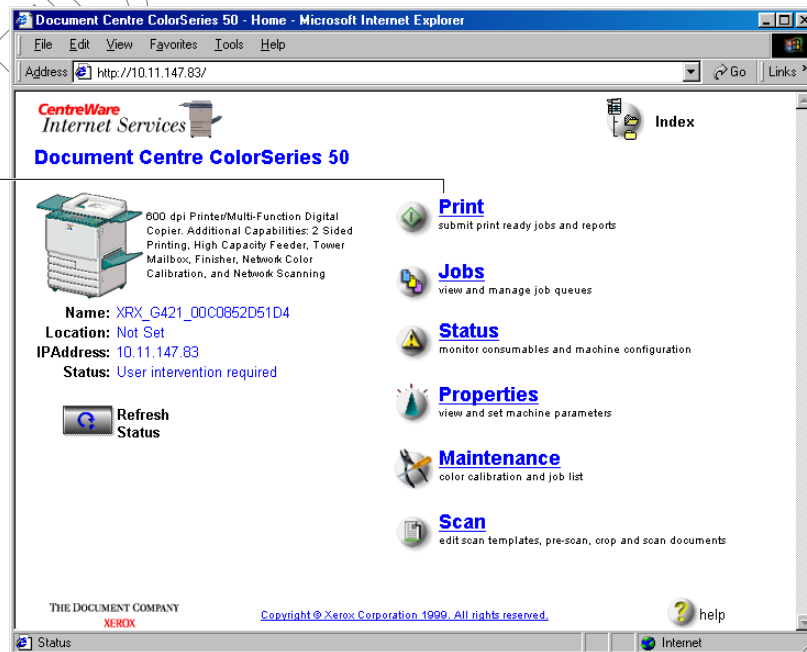
- If the DCCS50 is off, turn it on and allow it to warm up.
- If the DCCS50 is on, make sure it is not processing a job. Turn it off, wait 30 seconds, and then turn it on and allow it to warm up.

A Configuration Report prints automatically when the DCCS50 finishes warming up. The IP address is printed in the section **Network Setup, TCP/IP**.

NOTE: If a Config. Report doesn't print, ask the Network Administrator for assistance.

2. Locate a Windows PC that has a CD-ROM drive and an internet browser, is connected to the network, and can print to the DCCS50.
3. Insert the System Software Update CD in the PC's CD-ROM drive.
4. Launch the internet browser and enter the IP address of the DCCS50.
5. Click the **Print link**.

6. Click job submission.
7. Browse to the PC's CD-ROM drive and select the file 1-7NJXZ.ps.
8. Click the Print button.

When the update file finishes downloading to the DCCS50, the message 1-7NJXZ.ps has been submitted 1 MB appears on the screen.

The DCCS50 reboots and automatically prints a Configuration Report. If you wish to print a Configuration Report manually:

- Click reports
- Set the Report Type to Configuration
- Click the Print button

9. On the Configuration Report, verify that the Machine Information section includes: 1-7NJXZ.
10. Remove the System Software Update CD from the PC's CD-ROM drive and store it with the associated system software CDs.

Reinstall this update file whenever you reinstall system software.
