


Fig. 1-3 Select **System Settings**.




Fig. 1-4 Select **System Settings**.




Fig. 1-5 Select Common Settings.
















Fig. 2-3 Select **System Settings**.







Fig. 2-5 Select **Fax Mode Settings**.






Select Close on the Fax Mode Settings screen.








Fig. 3-3 Select **System Settings**.







Fig. 3-5 Select Common Settings.






Fig. 3-10 Select **Screen Defaults**.




