

## README FIRST for 1-G88R5

This patch contains the following Microsoft Hotfix:

- Q828741 - MS04-012

Please use these installation instructions for installing the 1-G88R5 MS Security Patch for MS04-012.

***Please note:*** *This patch is not installed by the usual Fiery method. Due to the complexity of this particular patch, a simple .ps downloadable patch is not available.*

### Installation Steps

1. Unzip the 1-G88R5.zip file to a folder on a Windows PC.
2. On a Windows PC, select <Start> <Run>.
3. Enter the IP address of your Fiery; \\<Fiery\_ip\_address>\d\$, <OK>. If prompted for a username and password, enter 'Administrator' as the username, and 'Fiery.1' as the password.
4. A window will open displaying the contents of the Fiery D drive; create a new folder, such as 'Patch 1-G88R5'.
5. Open the folder and copy the unzipped files from Step 1 into this folder.
6. Close the Fiery D drive window.
7. At the Fiery, select <Start> <Computer> <D drive>. If the files are hidden on the D drive, select <Show the contents of this folder>.
8. Double click on the 'patch.bat' file. (The file may have the .bat extension, or be identified in the file details)
9. When the 'patch.bat' file completes executing, the instructions will state to press any key. A window will pop up stating that the system will reboot in 30 seconds and a countdown will begin.

***NOTE1:*** *Ignore the error messages displayed in the DOS window while the batch file is executing.*

***NOTE2:*** *If the batch file does not complete after 5 minutes, stop the patch.bat and try again.*

10. After the Fiery reboots, print a Configuration page; ensure that '1-G88R5' appears under 'Update Information'. **This is your confirmation that the patch has been installed.**

***Important:*** *There is currently no scan utility that will detect Microsoft patches on an XPe (embedded) Operating System. If you run a scan utility after installing 1-G88R5, MS04-012 will not show up in the report. If 1-G88R5 is listed on the Configuration page, MS04-012 patch is installed.*
