

Xerox Print Service Plugin Privacy Policy

Introduction

This privacy policy covers the Xerox Print Service Plugin ("XPS") belonging to Xerox Corporation ("Xerox" or "we") in the United States.

Xerox is committed to respecting your privacy and complying with applicable data protection and privacy laws. We have provided this privacy policy to help you understand how we collect, use, and protect your information. We wish to help you make informed decisions; therefore, please take a few moments to read the sections below and learn how we may use your personal information. Your use of XPS indicates that you have read, accepted and agreed to this privacy policy and any other applicable terms.

- Xerox informs its mobile application users ("you") how it uses personally identifiable information that is collected via its mobile applications;
- We maintain confidentiality and security safeguards for personally identifiable information;
- You have control over personally identifiable information you decide to submit to XPS; and
- You can opt-out of receiving commercial messages from XPS at any time.

Xerox maintains the information it receives via its mobile applications in strict confidence; information you submit through XPS is not sold to or shared with third parties, except our subsidiaries, affiliates, agents and partners as described in this policy.

Xerox reserves the right to notify you about administrative matters that pertain to XPS. We may disclose your personally identifiable information, as required by law or regulation, in connection with law enforcement, fraud prevention, or other legal action; or if we reasonably believe it is necessary to protect Xerox, our customers, or the public. Although Xerox does not currently anticipate a change in our corporate status, in the event of a merger or acquisition of the company or a substantial portion of its assets, Xerox may disclose or transfer personal information collected via XPS to the surviving or acquiring party, respectively.

Collection of Personally Identifiable Information

You may choose to give us personally identifiable information via the mobile application to allow us to communicate with you or provide you with services. If you request us to perform troubleshooting, Xerox may access the documents you choose to submit to XPS. You have control over the content of the documents you submit to XPS. To use XPS you may need to provide your current device location. In order to research and improve our services, we may analyze anonymized data provided to XPS. You can always opt-out from this XPS service.

XPS is not directed to, or intended for, children and does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children. By downloading or using XPS, you affirm that you are at least eighteen (18) years old and that you understand and agree to comply with this privacy policy and the End User License Agreement.

Personally identifiable information collected may be stored and processed in the United States or any other country in which Xerox or its subsidiaries, affiliates, agents or partners maintain facilities, and by using this mobile application, you consent to any such transfer of information outside of your country.

Why Does XPS Collect Personally Identifiable Information?

XPS may use personally identifiable information submitted via its mobile applications to route requests to the correct Xerox Mobile Print Solution deployment for your account.

Communication Preferences.

XPS does not send commercial mobile application messages to you advertising our products and services. Our mobile application communications with you are primarily administrative and transactional notices, the purpose of which is not promotional in nature.

Security of Personally Identifiable Information

Xerox maintains strict access control over personally identifiable information.

Only authorized Xerox personnel, and those of our subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, and partners are allowed to handle information submitted to XPS.

Personally identifiable information is stored in password-protected environments and is subject to industry-standard information security policies, standards, and procedures. Your documents may pass through one or more servers for conversion before being printed. Although we take reasonable steps to protect your information, no website, internet transmission, computer system or wireless connection is completely secure.

Our agents and partners protect personally identifiable information.

When you arrange for services via XPS, it may be necessary to transfer personally identifiable information to our subsidiaries, affiliates, agents or partners, who then provide the services. Xerox requires that its subsidiaries, affiliates, agents and partners handle personally identifiable information with the same concern for personal privacy as Xerox.

Access to Information

You may contact Xerox to check the accuracy of your personally identifiable information or to request that your information be updated or deleted by contacting us at the email address contained in the application under "Support". Xerox reserves the right to confirm your identity and to modify the scope and number of requests.

Google Analytics

How does XPS use Google Analytics?

We use Google Analytics to track usage and activity of XPS. Google Analytics may collect information automatically from you through the use of their analytics ID. An analytics ID is a specific string of numbers or letters that is assigned to your device but does not name you. The analytics ID allows Google to track your behavior and automatically collect data, including data regarding your use of your mobile device and your use of XPS. This data may include the number of print jobs you have performed using XPS, printer model and print options used and feedback from you regarding your use of the application. Google Analytics provides us with aggregate information about the use of XPS. It does not provide information about specific users that would allow us to personally identify you. We use the information we receive from Google Analytics to understand how individuals are using our application and to make improvements. Read more about how Google Analytics uses your information [here](#). In your XPS settings, you may disable the automatic collection of data by turning off Google Analytics. If your version of XPS does not contain this setting then Google Analytics is not being used in your version of the application.
